

Investigation of Consciousness for Own Facial Appearance between Japanese and Korean

The purpose of this study was to investigate how laypersons are aware of their own faces via a questionnaire between Japanese and Korean. The selected subjects were Sixty Japanese and 60 Korean females from 18 to 27 years old, who are students in Dental Hygienist Academy. All subjects are asked to fill out a questionnaire about awareness of their own facial appearance describing focusing on the visual impression. The Japanese and Koreans are similar anatomically. However, they chose the one that will completely different likes of own face. In addition, Japanese compared to Koreans, had to feel about the front than profile, and especially for nasolabial. Compare Koreans, Japanese felt a very dissatisfaction for their own profile.
